This is a high-level list of the changes that have been made to the Range Rules adopted approximately 2 years ago. It is not a detailed list of all changes. Many other people provided insightful comments and suggestions. The Board of Directors has reviewed the Range Rules, requested changes and recommends approval by the membership of Version 10 dated 2018-01-22.

General Notes:

1. Added a header to each page.
2. Added the version date to each footer.
3. Reformatted
 - a. Section titles are now a consistent style.
 - b. Lettered each subsection.
 - c. Rule numbers start at 1 for each section.
4. The terms “impact area”, “member/RBH” and “Mt. Airy Chapter IWLA” are now used consistently throughout.
5. Added consistent subsection titles throughout.
